CAPITALIZE

- 1. the first word of every sentence
- 2. the names of the days of the week, months, and holidays, but not the seasons
- 3. all proper nouns (names of specific people, places, things)

 John Smith Kelowna Diet Pepsi
- 4. the regions of the country but not compass points or directions the Far East Drive east.
- people's titles when used with or in place of their names
 Mr. Smith General Smith Mayor Smith
 Mom, can you drive me east? NOT My mom is a good driver.
- 6. specific organization, companies, schools, hospitals, places of worship, buildings. the Eiffel Tower Chief Tomat Elementary Kelowna General Hospital
- 7. the first word in a direct quotation
- 8. nouns/adjectives that refer to specific languages, nationalities, races, and religions.
- 9. the first and all other important words in a title <u>To Kill a Mockingbird</u>
