## 1.2 Pre-reading Assignment

Go to this link for [The Mystery of the Cyber Bully](#). Follow all the pre-reading steps below to learn about the book. For #2 - 7, write a paragraph just like the example for *Kawlija's Blueberry Promise*. For number seven, simply write your list of questions. Always check your work over for conventions (such as capitals), usage (grammar), punctuation, spelling - CUPS!

1) Find the author's name and book title

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2) Look at the pictures (What do the pictures let you know about the story or text? What ideas are being presented? What do the pictures make you think of? What do the captions suggest?)

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3) Read the book jacket, summary, and/or review. What do they tell you? Do they remind you of any other books? Do they remind you of anything in your own life or the world around you?

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4) Look at charts and maps. (If there are none you can skip this step.)

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5) Look for big ideas. (Are there chapter titles, headings, or subheadings? Look for the big ideas you think the author wants to get across. See if you can make connections with the text and images. Compare them to what you know about the world already.)

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6) Read the first and last sentence from a paragraph or two from the sample chapter. What information did you get about what you are going to read? What does it make you think about?

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7) Ask questions! Come up with at least two questions you have about the book. Think about different kinds of questions – who, what, where, when, and the big two - why and how.

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
