


Inquiry Question

General Instructions

There are four parts to this project.

First take the Political Compass Test: <https://www.politicalcompass.org/test>

Second, after reviewing your Political Compass results answer the following questions with complete sentences, please number your answers and include a list of sources.

- 1) Where did you end up on the political spectrum? Who are you nearest to?
- 2) Write two sentences describing the person that you were nearest to on the graph.
- 3) Were you surprised by your results? Why or why not?
- 4) Did you understand all of the questions? If not, which questions did you not understand?
- 5) If you were of voting in the next election do you think that this would influence your vote? Why or why not? Your answer should be at least 4 sentences long.

Third, find three people to take the Political Compass test and interview them about their results. Come up with a series of questions similar to the ones above. Really make the subjects think about their world views, challenge them to defend their positions.

Create a 5-minute, carefully crafted and well supported (audio or video) series of interviews using the proper APA format for references.

Record your interview using Audacity <http://audacity.sourceforge.net/>, GarageBand, iMovie or other recording software with capacity to edit sound.



